

CMPS 260 Project Naming Conventions

1. A link to your class directory will appear in your UCS account as follows:

`cs260x` where x is your section number

2. A directory for each programming project must be located in your class directory. All code for the project must be submitted from this directory. The directory for each project will be named as follows:

`projx` where x is the number of the programming project

example: `proj1`

3. The name of files containing code should have the extensions “.h” or “.cpp”, whichever is appropriate.

4. The name of the file containing the function *main* (i.e. the project driver) must be named as follows:

`projx.cpp` where x is the number of the programming project

example: `proj1.cpp`
